**MHS Student Parking & Driving Regulations 2020-21 SY**

- Parking permits will cost \$25.00. A valid Driver's License, proof of current insurance coverage and the Registration card is required before issuance of the parking decal.
- Drivers should exercise extreme caution during inclement weather, dismissal, etc.
- **NO LOITERING IN THE PARKING LOT.**
- Once you arrive on campus, you will not be allowed to sit in your car until the bell RINGS OR return to your car until the end of your school day.
- You may not leave during the school day for any reason without permission from an Administrator. Failure to follow procedure will result in loss of driving privileges.
- If you have early dismissal, you have 5 minutes to leave campus after your last class.
- You must park in the student parking lot.
- Loud music or careless driving will not be tolerated. Students may not drive over 20mph on school campus.
- Parking Decals must be displayed and visible at all times.
- The driver is responsible for items/persons in their vehicle at all times while on campus. Drugs, weapons, ammunition alcohol and/or other illegal items are not allowed on school campus.
- No parking in the "bus parking lot" during school hours, during loading and off-loading hours.
- **Students who attend F.E. DuBose/CCTC will be required to ride the bus to that campus. Students who attend 1st period may drive to F.E. DuBose from home and then park on the campus of MHS in the student parking lot. If you have an afternoon class, you may drive and should not return to campus, unless you are in a supervised afterschool activity at 3:30pm. Students may not ride together unless you are living in the same household. Riding other students in your car may result in a loss of driving privileges.**
- Students are not allowed to bring food purchased off campus back to into the building or for other students during the school day. **THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- You may refer to the student handbook for the range of consequences. Safety is a priority and driving on campus is a privilege.
- Driving privileges may be revoked by Administration at any time during the school year.
- Students may not use their vehicle as a locker during the school day. Once the school day has begun, students are not permitted to return to their car unless an administrator grants permission.

*Pursuant to ACT 373 of 1994, persons entering school grounds deem to have consented to a search of their person and property. Random searches will be conducted by K-9 units. All accidents should be reported to the SRO, and an Administrator immediately.*

We, the Student and Parent, have read the above stated guidelines and received a copy for our records. We are aware than ANY violations of the stated regulations may result in the loss or suspension of Driving Privileges.
