January 28, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Lucreia Bennett. The minutes of the December minutes were given to members to read. A motion and second were made to accept the minutes as given, and an "1" vote carried the motion. The meeting followed the agenda.

Chairperson Lucreia Bennett reported on the CSD2 SIC training presented by the state SIC Representative Karen Utter from Columbia, SC. Information shared included role of SIC, attendance requirements, planning and reporting meetings, establishing goals, meeting dates, and where minutes are maintained. Each meeting should include a guest speaker. A copy of the PowerPoint was given to the secretary and can be reviewed for additional information. Ms. Johanna Bethune-Wilson, chairperson at the MJHS SIC requests to speak and visit an upcoming MHS SIC meeting, and Principal Threatt will try to schedule her for the next meeting. Principal Threatt gave reports on the MHS Basketball teams making the play-offs to be held February 11 (girls) and February 12 (boys). The superintendent search continues, and a handout on each of the 4 candidates was given to members to review. Each candidate will visit every school in the district, one each day. A Black History program is planned for February with Cecil Williams, professional photographer and artist as guest speaker. The AdvanceEd Accreditation team visit will be in April. They will be meeting with parent representatives.

In discussion time, Chairperson Bennett reported that one goal has been achieved. MHS art work has been placed in the front hall of the Clarendon Administrative building. Art work previously was displayed on a back wall with private school art work in the front. At the next meeting Principal Threatt will plan to update community on the budget process. Possible guest speakers were suggested as follows: MJHS SIC chairperson, Superintendent Tindal, counselor presentation on getting students ready for the senior year, assistant principal on course offerings for next year, and Student Council president addressing affairs this year. Announcements included the 8th grade parent night to address upcoming IGP's on February 13 at MJHS, and MHS IGP's beginning on February 4. Members were encouraged to share ideas and concerns with the Principal and Chairperson. The next meeting will be February 25, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Media Center. A motion and second were made to adjourn.
