Tuesday, August 21, 2018 - 5:30 p.m.

1. Mrs. Linda P. Lemon, Board Vice-Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. The Board paused for a moment of silence.
3. Mrs. Sweat led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mrs. Lemon stated The Clarendon Citizen, The Manning Times and The Clarendon Sun were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of the meeting via facsimile and email. No one from the media was present.
5. Without objection, the agenda was approved.
6. Without objection, the minutes of the last meetings were approved.
7. No one addressed the Board during the public comment period.
8. Dr. Susan Thomas from the South Carolina Department of Education made a presentation on the district's PBIS Program which was received as information.

Mr. Steven Evans from the University of South Carolina Sumter Campus made a presentation on the Manning High School Upward Bound Program which was received as information.

9. At 5:57 p.m., Mr. Prince made a motion to go into Executive Session for Student Hearings. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

At 7:27 p.m., Mr. Land made a motion to come out of Executive Session. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously. No action was taken at this time.

10. Mrs. Tiffany Ballard appeared before the Board to request release of her children, Treyshon Greene, Aiyana Greene and Ariel Ballard to attend Sumter School District for the 2018-2019 school year. After discussion, Mr. Land made a motion to approve the release of three (3) students from Clarendon School District Two to attend Sumter School District for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Harrington seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Tindal presented to the Board a request to waive the fee for the use of Manning Elementary School Gymnasium and Cafeteria from Mr. J. Pringle and the Masonic

Lodge for a Masonic Banquet on November 3, 2018. After discussion, Mrs. Sweat made a motion to approve the waiver for the use of Manning Elementary School on November 3, 2018, however; they would have to pay the custodial fee and provide liability insurance. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

11. Mrs. Cathy Williams presented the monthly financial report; of which, a copy is on file in the district office.
12. Dr. McCathern presented the Personnel Update Report. It was received as information.
13. Mrs. Gibbons presented the Title I Plan for the 2018-2019 school year. After discussion, Mrs. Harrington made a motion to approve the Title I Plan for the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
14. At 7:40 p.m., Mr. Prince moved to go into Executive Session for Recommendations /Reports on Employee Matters. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
15. At 8:40 p.m., Mr. Prince moved to come out of Executive Session. Mr. Fleming seconded the motion which passed unanimously. The following actions were taken:

Mr. Land made a motion to readmit **Student A** to Manning High School for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Moyd made a motion to readmit **Student B** to Monarch Academy for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Wilson made a motion to readmit **Student C** to Monarch Academy for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Harrington made a motion to readmit **Student D** to Monarch Academy for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. Land recused himself from the vote.

Mr. Prince made a motion to readmit **Student E** to Monarch Academy for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Sweat made a motion to readmit **Student F** to Manning High School for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation. Mr. Fleming seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. Land recused himself from the vote.

Mr. Fleming made a motion to readmit **Student G** to Manning High School for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Moyd made a motion to accept the superintendent's recommendation to employ an Interim Assistant Principal at Manning Elementary School for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

16. Information from the Superintendent included the following:

- Mr. Tindal reported the enrollment numbers for the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year.
- Mr. Tindal also informed the Board that cameras will be installed at Manning High School, the Athletic Field House and Manning Elementary School starting on Monday, August 27, 2018. He said that he would update them as soon as they were completed.
- Mr. Tindal also informed the Board that the gym floors at Manning Junior High School was completed and that the Primary School floors are being checked.
- Mr. Tindal also shared with the Board pictures of the Media Center at Manning High School. He said that Mrs. Trulsen thanked the Board for their help in getting the Media Center floors done.
