Clarendon School District Two
Board of Trustees
Tuesday, July 17, 2018 - 5:30 p.m.
District Office Boardroom

Mr. Tindal presented newly appointed Board member, Betty G. Harrington, to be sworn in as new Board member. Judge James Dingle administered the oath of office to Mrs. Harrington. Mr. Tindal also presented former Board Secretary, Jerry L. Coker with a plaque for his years of service as a Board member. Mr. Coker commented on what an honor it was to be part of the Clarendon School District Two Board of Trustees. Judge Dingle also thanked Mrs. Harrington for her service with the school district and for her agreeing to serve on the school board.

1. Mr. Arthur J. Moyd, Sr., Board Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m.
2. The Board paused for a moment of silence.
3. Mrs. Sweat led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mr. Moyd stated The Clarendon Citizen, The Manning Times and The Clarendon Sun were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of the meeting via facsimile and email. No one from the media was present. Mr. Moyd recognized Ms. Sue Avins, who was a visitor at the board meeting.
5. Without objection, the agenda was approved.
6. Without objection, the minutes of the last meetings were approved.
7. No one addressed the Board during the public comment period.
8. The Superintendent then took over the chair and conducted the election of board officers for the 2018-2019 school year.

Mr. Prince nominated Ms. Kimberly O. Johnson for Chair, Mrs. Sweat seconded the nomination. Mr. Tindal asked if there were any other nominations, hearing none, Ms. Johnson was elected by acclamation.

Ms. Johnson declared the floor open for Vice-Chair. Mr. Moyd nominated Mrs. Linda P. Lemon for Vice-Chair, Mr. Land seconded the nomination. Ms. Johnson asked if there were any other nominations, hearing none, Mrs. Lemon was elected Vice-Chair by acclamation.

Ms. Johnson declared the floor open for Secretary. Mr. Land nominated Mrs. Betty G. Harrington for Secretary. Mr. Prince seconded the nomination. Ms. Johnson asked if there were any other nominations, hearing none, Mrs. Harrington was elected Secretary by acclamation.

Mr. Land made a motion to nominate elected Board Chairwoman, Ms. Kimberly O. Johnson to serve as the Clarendon School District Two Education Foundation representative for the 2018-2019 SY. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Land made a motion to nominate Mr. Arthur J. Moyd, Sr. and Mr. Robert Fleming as representatives for the Board Legislative Contact for the 2018-2019 SY. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Alonzo McDonald presented to the Board a request for an overnight field trip to take seven (7) Manning High School FFA students to the SC FFA Camp in Cherry Grove on July 30 – August 3, 2018. After discussion, Mr. Prince made a motion to approve the Manning High School FFA to go to the SC FFA Camp on July 30 – August 3, 2018 in Cherry Grove. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. Prince asked Mr. McDonald to make sure that there was a male and female chaperone for the students.

Mr. Tindal read a letter to the Board from Mr. Harvin Pressley to request release of his child, Haze Pressley to attend Sumter County School District. After discussion, Mr. Prince made a motion to approve the release of one (1) student from Clarendon School District Two to attend Sumter County School District for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Angela Mahoney appeared before the Board to request release of her child, Mattie Mahoney to attend Clarendon School District Three. After discussion, Mr. Moyd made a motion to approve the release of one (1) student from Clarendon School District Two to attend Clarendon School District Three for the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Tindal presented to the Board a request to waive the fee for the use of Manning Junior High School gymnasium from Ms. Sonia Daniel for July 28, 2018 for a Benefit Gospel Program to assist Sharon Miller in her recovery. After discussion, Mr. Land made a motion to approve the waiver for the use of Manning Junior High School gymnasium on July 28, 2018, however; they would have to pay the custodial fee and provide liability insurance. Mrs. Harrington seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Tindal presented to the Board a request to waive the fee for the use of Manning High School gymnasium and track area from Ms. Margaret Robertson and the Clarendon Pilot Club to sponsor the Clarendon Pilot Club Walk for Brain Health to be held on October 6, 2018. After discussion, Mrs. Sweat made a motion to approve the waiver for the use of Manning High School gymnasium and track area on October 6,

2018, however; they would have to pay the custodial fee and provide liability insurance.

Mr. Tindal also presented to the Board a request to waive the fee for the use of Manning Junior High School gymnasium from Ms. Annette Lloyd Calvin to have a Retirement Dinner on August 11, 2018. After discussion, Mr. Land made a motion to approve the use of Manning Junior High School gymnasium on August 11, 2018, however; she will have to pay the custodial fee and provide liability insurance. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

9. Cathy Williams presented the monthly financial report; of which a copy is on file in the district office.
10. Dr. McCathern presented the Personnel Update Report. It was received as information.
11. Mrs. Gibbons presented the Title I – Direct Student Services (DSS) grant for the 2018-2019 school year. After discussion, Mr. Land made a motion to approve the Title I – Direct Student Services (DSS) for the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
12. At 6:04 p.m., Mr. Prince moved to go into Executive Session for Recommendations /Reports on Employee Matters. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
13. At 8:02 p.m., Mr. Prince moved to come out of Executive Session. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously. The following action was taken:

Mr. Land made a motion to allow one (1) paraprofessional a Leave of Absence for sixteen (16) weeks for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. Fleming recused himself from the vote.

Mrs. Sweat made a motion to accept the recommendation of the superintendent to hire two (2) certified employees for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. Fleming recused himself from the vote.

Mr. Moyd made a motion to release one (1) certified personnel from their 2018-2019 contract. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which failed with a 1 to 7 vote.

Mrs. Harrington made a motion to allow the tree trimming company to trim the trees near the Manning High School in order to make the billboard signs visible. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

14. Information from the Superintendent included the following:

- Mr. Tindal presented to the Board the milk bid for the Food Services Department. After discussion, Mrs. Wilson made a motion to approve the Borden milk bid of .2235 for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
- Mr. Tindal read a thank you card for the family of Edith Driggers Coker.
- Mr. Tindal reminded the Board that we will be having student expulsion hearings on July 23, 24, and 25, 2018 beginning at 5:00 p.m. at the district office.
- Mr. Tindal also wished Mrs. Harrington a Happy Birthday.

15. At 8:10 p.m., Mr. Prince made a motion to adjourn. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
