1. Ms. Kimberly O. Johnson, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. The Board paused for a moment of silence.
3. Mrs. Wilson led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Ms. Johnson stated The Clarendon Citizen, The Manning Times and The Clarendon Sun were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of the meeting via facsimile and email. No one from the media was present.
5. Without objection, the agenda was approved.
6. No one addressed the Board during the public comment period.
7. Mr. Tindal presented Mr. Matthew Prince who presented to the board a book that was written by his daughter-in-law, Tamika L. Prince entitled "Justin's pumpkin patch adventure". Mr. Prince and his daughter-in-law wanted every first grade teacher at Manning Early Childhood Center to receive this book. Mr. Prince asked that Mr. Tindal deliver the book to each teacher.

Mr. Land made a motion to expel **Student C** for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Sweat made a motion to accept the superintendent's recommendation to release one (1) English teacher from Manning Junior High School for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Prince made a motion for the Board to honor a request made by Mrs. Marie Land to assist in purchasing a gazebo for Manning Early Childhood Center. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. William Ceth Land recused himself from the vote.

11. Information from the Superintendent:

- Mr. Tindal informed the Board that due to the impending weather conditions of Hurricane Michael, the schools and offices will be closed on tomorrow, Thursday, October 11, 2019.
- Mr. Tindal also informed the Board that Manning Junior High School football team won their conference game and are going to the playoffs. Playoff game will be held on Tuesday, October 16, 2018 at Ramsey Stadium.
