1. Ms. Johnson, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. The Board paused for a moment of silence.
3. Mr. Fleming led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Ms. Johnson stated The Clarendon Citizen, The Manning Times and The Clarendon Sun were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of the meeting via email. No one from the media was present.
5. Without objection the agenda was approved.
6. No one addressed the Board during the public comment period.
7. At 5:31p.m. Mr. Prince made a motion to go into Executive Session for Student Hearings and Recommendations/Reports on Employee Matters. Mrs. Harrington seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
8. At 7:10 p.m. Mr. Land made a motion to come out of Executive Session. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously. The following actions were taken:

Mr. Moyd made a motion to expel **Student A** for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Wilson made a motion to expel **Student B** for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. Land recused himself from this vote.

Mr. Prince made a motion to allow **Student C** to go to Monarch Academy under strict probation. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Lemon made a motion to allow **Student D** to go to Monarch Academy under strict probation. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Harrington made a motion to employ one (1) certified teacher for Manning Elementary School for the 2019-2020 school year. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Land made a motion to employ one (1) certified teacher for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Sweat made a motion to accept the resignation of the athletic director for Manning High School effective June 20, 2019 and instruct the superintendent to advertise. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

9. Mr. Tindal then led the Board Budget Work Session, of which Dr. Shawn Johnson, superintendent elect, joined in via skype. During the session, the following motions were made:

Mr. Land made a motion to accept the bid from Campbell Pavement Specialty to work on the Manning Junior High School parking lot and road at their bid price. Mr. Moyd seconded them motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Moyd made a motion to accept the bid of Air Solution to provide and install new HVAC units at Alcolu Head Start, Manning Junior High School and Manning High School at their bid price. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

- Mr. Tindal also reminded the Board about the budget work session on March 26, 2019.
 - Mr. Tindal also reminded the Board that their SC Ethics Commission reports are due by March 30, 2018.
 - Mr. Tindal also reminded the Board that 2DAC will be on March 13, 2019 in Columbia, South Carolina.
 - Mr. Tindal also informed the Board that the FACES teachers were approved for a two-year extension by the U.S. State Department.
