

**MINUTES**  
**Clarendon School District Two**  
**Board of Trustees**  
**Tuesday, October 16, 2018 - 5:30 p.m.**

1. Mrs. Lemon, Board Vice-Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. The Board paused for a moment of silence.
3. Mrs. Wilson led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mrs. Lemon stated The Clarendon Citizen, The Manning Times and The Clarendon Sun were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of the meeting via facsimile and email. No one from the media was present.
5. Mr. Moyd made a motion to approve the agenda as outlined. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
6. Mr. Moyd made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meetings. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
7. No one addressed the Board during the public comment period.
8. Mr. Tindal presented a certificate to Mrs. Mary Huckaby for being a recipient of the Donors Choose for her project "Wobble Seats for Wiggle Worms".
9. Mr. Glen Wells and Mrs. Lucy Cadet of New York Life Insurance made a presentation to the Board which was received as information.
10. Ms. Christy Nexsen along with her student teacher Allison Harrison presented an overnight field trip request for twenty-nine (29) students to go to Camp Bob Cooper on April 1-3, 2019. After discussion, Mr. Land made a motion to approve the overnight field trip request for the students to go to Camp Bob Cooper on April 1-3, 2019. Mrs. Harrington seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Ms. Tracie Dury, teacher at Manning High School, presented an overnight field trip request for the Senior Class of 2019 to go to Orlando, Florida for their Senior Class Trip, April 5-8, 2019. After much discussion, Mrs. Sweat made a motion to approve the overnight field trip request for the Senior Class of 2019 to go to Orlando, Florida on April 5-8, 2019; however, they would need to make sure they had enough male and female chaperones for the trip. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

He also moved that if Deputy Smith wanted to use the Manning Elementary School, the Board would revisit waiving the fee for Manning Elementary School. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

11. Mrs. Cathy Williams presented the monthly financial report; of which a copy is on file in the district office.
12. Dr. McCathern presented the Personnel Update Report. It was received as information.
13. At 5:58 p.m., Mr. Prince moved to go into Executive Session for Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendations /Reports on Employee Matters. Mr. Fleming seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
14. At 6:32 p.m., Mr. Prince moved to come out of Executive Session. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously. The following actions were taken:

Mr. Land made a motion to approve paraprofessionals who are student teachers, who are seeking to obtain a teaching certificate, to receive their salary while they are student teaching, however; they must commit three (3) years to Clarendon School District Two starting with the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

15. Information from the Superintendent included the following:

Mr. Prince also announced that his daughter-in-law, Mrs. Tameika Prince, who donated a copy of her book to all of the 1<sup>st</sup> grade teachers at Manning Early Childhood, will have a book signing on November 10, 2018.
