1. Miss Kimberly O. Johnson, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m.
2. The Board paused for a moment of silence.
3. Mrs. Lemon led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Miss Johnson stated The Clarendon Citizen, The Manning Times and The Clarendon Sun were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of the meeting via facsimile and email. No one from the media was present.
5. Without objection, the agenda was approved.
6. No one addressed the Board during the public comment period.
7. Ms. Sarafina Armstrong appeared before the Board to request the release of her son to attend Sumter School District. After discussion, Mr. Moyd made a motion to approve the release of one (1) student from Clarendon School District Two to attend Sumter School District for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Ms. Christina Sikes appeared before the Board to request release of her child, to attend Sumter County School District. After discussion, Mrs. Wilson made a motion to approve the release of one (1) student from Clarendon School District Two to attend Sumter County School District for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Tindal presented to the Board a request to waive the fee for the use of Manning Junior High School from Mr. Floyd Keels and the William Penn Harrison Educational Scholarship Foundation to host their Annual Scholarship Gala on November 23, 2018. After discussion, Mr. Land made a motion to approve the waiver for the use of Manning High School with the exception to pay the custodial staff and to provide liability insurance. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

8. At 5:10 p.m. Mr. Prince made a motion to go into Executive Session regarding Employee Matter, Student Hearings, and Recommendations/Reports on Employee Matters. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

9. At 7:15 p.m. Mr. Prince made a motion to come out of Executive Session. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously. The following actions were taken:

Mr. Prince made a motion to re-admit **Student A** to Manning High School for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation and that **Student A** must attend the Fresh Start Program. Mr. Fleming seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Wilson made a motion to re-admit **Student B** to Manning High School for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation and that **Student B** must attend the Fresh Start Program. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Harrington made a motion to re-admit **Student C** to Manning High School for the 2018-2019 school year under strict probation and that **Student C** must attend the Fresh Start Program. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Land made a motion to retain Parker Poe for the Farmer's Telephone litigation. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. Moyd made a motion to release one (1) certified employee from their 2018-2019 school year contract. Mr. Land seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

10. Information from the Superintendent:

- Mr. Tindal reminded the Board that the new cameras for the High School and the Field House are coming in soon and will be installed.
