1. Ms. Kimberly O. Johnson, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
2. The Board paused for a moment of silence.
3. Mr. Prince led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Ms. Johnson stated The Clarendon Citizen, The Manning Times and The Clarendon Sun were notified of the time, date, place and agenda of the meeting via facsimile and email. No one from the media was present.
5. Without objection, the agenda was approved.
6. No one addressed the Board during the public comment period.
7. At 5:35 p.m. Mr. Land made a motion to go into Executive Session for Request for Release of Student due to the nature of the request. Mr. Prince seconded the motion which passed unanimously. At 5:39 p.m., Mr. Prince made a motion to come out of Executive Session. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Mr. Prince made a motion to approve the release of one (1) student from Clarendon School District Two to attend Sumter County School District for the 2018-2019 school year. Mrs. Sweat seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
8. At 5:40 p.m. Mr. Land made a motion to go into Executive Session regarding SCSBA Contractual Matter, Hearing Officer's Report and Recommendations/Reports on Employee Matters. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
9. At 7:50 p.m. Mr. Prince made a motion to come out of Executive Session. Mrs. Lemon seconded the motion which passed unanimously. The following actions were taken:

Mrs. Wilson made a motion to accept the recommendation of the superintendent to employ an Interim Assistant Principal for Manning Primary School for the 2018-2019 school year. Mr. Moyd seconded the motion which passed with a 4 to 3 vote.

Mr. Prince made a motion to employ one part-time teacher for Manning Elementary School from August 2018 to December 2018. Mrs. Wilson seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

10. Information from the Superintendent:

- Mr. Tindal informed the Board that the district was a recipient of the 2018 SRO Funding from the State Department of Education as he was assigning the SRO to Manning Early Childhood Center.
- Mr. Tindal also informed the Board that the new Monarch Academy sign was up in the building.
- Mr. Tindal informed the Board that during the recent storm, there was a power outage at Manning High School and they were looking into the situation.
- Mr. Tindal also discussed with the Board that there were students at the Monarch Academy who did not have money to buy their uniforms. After discussion, Mr. Tindal told the Board that he was going to donate some funds to the families who were in need. Mr. Prince and Mr. Fleming also made a donation.
